Rules

1. Participants may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in on Tuesday, April 20th at the Pancake Supper.**
2. Pledges may be made by anyone.. **Please ask everyone who pledges if their company has a matching gift fund policy.** Companies who do match pledge gifts are listed on the back of the pledge sheet.
3. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per mile, and maximum pledge.** You may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.
4. On walk-a-thon day, each participant will be asked to meet at the Town Hall in front of the fountain, located on Maiden Lane in Lexington, SC. Walk starting point. You will need to arrive no later than 8:30am.
5. Upon completion of the walk-a-thon, families will be asked to journey to the park to participate in the Kid's Day activities and support the vendors. Announcements will be made from the stage regarding the first family to complete the walk.
6. No running or jogging will be allowed. Participants are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen if it's sunny or bring rain gear if it's rainy.
